Scheduling

The program is ongoing throughout the year with students participating in 3 skills-focused sessions in a 6-day cycle. Students will have approximately 100 hours of on-ice time throughout the year. There is a goal-tending instructor with the program.

Facilities

The program will continue to run out of Millennium Place.

Transportation / Equipment Storage

Students and equipment are transported to Millennium Place and back to Clover Bar on Clover Bar busses daily. Equipment can be stored at Clover Bar in a keypad secured out building that is monitored 24/7 with a security camera. Players and parents have 24/7 access to the storage building.

Program Cost

The projected cost for the 2017-2018 year will be \$1900.00. There is a \$500 deposit due upon acceptance into the Hockey Program. This deposit will be put towards the fee for this program.
