Description of field trip
 Students will take a bus to Jasper National Park and camp at Whistlers Campground. Students will set up their tents (2 per site) and cook their own meals. Shared stoves will be used. Students will explore the immediate area by doing Geo-caching and visiting other famous sites, such as Pyramid Lake (for moose spotting). Day 2 will incorporate a 25km hike to the Valley of 5 Lakes. Students will require a bagged lunch to be carried with them. Post dinner, students will take a bus ride to the Miette Hot Springs for a well deserved soak. Day 3 may include stops to national points of interest if time permits. Students will eat lunch en-route back to Sherwood Park.

 Setting up tents, cooking food on stove or fire, Geo-caching, day-hiking, soaking in hot springs.

Risks and safety precautions
 Wildlife in tent--no scented objects permitted in tent, everything is stored in bear-proof containers. Wildlife on trail--students review bear/cougar safety and must travel in groups of 8 or larger. Tics on trail--review how to prevent tics in class and what to do if one attaches to you. Getting lost or tripping on hike/Geo-caching--phones permitted on hikes, proper footwear will reduce tripping. Burning self on stove--use stove mitts or gloves to take hot pots off, fire pits are encased in small metal culverts to prevent injuries around fire. Drowning or falling on concrete at pool-- review rules prior to hot springs and lifeguards will be on duty.
