Clover Bar Mission Statement:

The Clover Bar program provides student athletes the opportunity to develop technically, physically, and psychologically within the game of soccer. Our program is based on the Canadian Soccer Associations' Long Term Player Development Model (LTPD), which allows for a strong player centered and coach driven environment.

Philosophy of the Soccer Program: To allow students to combine their passion for Soccer with their academic studies. The program is provided to help student Soccer players grow athletically, technically and academically. The Clover Bar program encourages and supports participation for both boys and girls from grades 7 through 9.

General Overview:

The program allows students to combine their passion for soccer alongside their academics throughout the school year. The program runs on alternate afternoons in conjunction with the school schedule. The class is open to both males and females from grade 7 to 9. The class is one of two electives that students choose alongside their core subject areas.

The Soccer Program is for students who:

- have passion for the sport of Soccer
- have desire to develop and improve their Soccer abilities
- have a great attitude about school and behavior profile
- are highly motivated and well-organized
- have a strong work ethic

With these attributes, students will have an enjoyable and successful experience athletically and academically at Clover Bar Junior High.

Facilities

The soccer fields behind Clover Bar Junior High School are used for the fall. During the winter, our students are bused to Millennium Place in Sherwood Park. In the spring, students are back at Clover Bar Junior High for the remainder of the year. Other soccer fields and fitness centers may be used during the course of the year.
