Dear Parents;

Grade 7 students have a wonderful opportunity to participate in a field trip to Strathcona Wilderness Centre on Friday September 21st, 2018. This is a teambuilding exercise that makes up part of Clover Bar's Welcome week activities. It also fits with the grade 7 science curriculum. Students will expand their knowledge of biological interactions, ecosystems and interdependence.

On this date, students will leave Clover Bar Jr. High after attendance and will proceed to the Strathcona Wilderness Centre where they will participate in activities including a predator-prey game and Team building games through the Strathcona ecosystem.

Students are asked to pack a bag lunch, as we will be eating outside and there is no food to purchase at the wilderness centre.
